Team assemblers will be required to be able to perform all tasks conducted by the team in the assembly process.

Tasks in addition to assembly may include: performing quality checks on products and components; packaging finished products and preparing them for shipment; maintain 5S workstations which may include some sweeping, moping and cleaning of work area; review work orders to ensure work orders to ensure work is performed according to specifications; maintain production equipment and machinery; provide assistance in the production of wiring assemblies;

In addition to the following skills the candidate must have basic understanding of raw materials, production processes, quality control, costs and other techniques for maximizing the effective manufacture and distribution of goods.

Skills:

- Coordination – Adjusting actions in relation to others' actions
- Monitoring – Monitoring/ Assessing performance of yourself, other individuals or organizations to suggest areas for improvements
- Quality Control Analysis – Ability to inspect products or processes to ensure the quality metric is met.
- Active Listening – Give full attention to what other people are saying, taking time to understand the points being made, asking questions as appropriate, and not interrupting at inappropriate times.

Abilities:

- Manual Dexterity – Ability to quickly move your hand, your hand together with your arm, or your two hands to grasp, manipulate, or assemble objects.



- Finger Dexterity – the ability to make precisely coordinated movements of the fingers of one or both hands to grasp, manipulate, or assemble very small objects.
- Problem Sensitivity – Ability to tell when something is wrong or is likely to go wrong. It does not involve solving the problem, only recognizing there is a problem.
- Near Vision – Ability to see details at close range (Within a few feet of the observer)
- Oral Comprehension – the Ability to listen to and understand information and ideas presented through spoken words and sentences.
- Arm Hand Steadiness – Ability to keep your hand and arm steady while moving your arm or while holding your arm and hand in one position.
- Deductive Reasoning – Ability to apply general rules to specific problems to produce answers that make sense.
- Information Ordering – Ability to arrange things or action in a certain order or pattern according to a specific rule or set of rules (e.g., patterns of numbers, letters, words, pictures, mathematical operations).
- Control Precision – Ability to quickly and repeatedly adjust the controls of a machine or vehicle to exact positions.
- Oral Expression – Ability to communicate information and ideas in speaking so others will understand.
